


Domain registrars can include GoDaddy.com, Namecheap.com, Aliyun.com, or any other reputable providers.

General process of domain transfer between registrars (e.g., Namecheap → GoDaddy):

1. Seller: Initiate a domain transfer-out from your Namecheap account, obtain the transfer (EPP/Auth) code, and share it with the buyer.

2. Buyer: Start the domain transfer-in through your GoDaddy account (<https://dcc.godaddy.com/control/transfers>):

3. Payment: Buyer pays the transfer fee (as domain renewal charge for a year) required by the registrar.

4. Completion: After payment, seller may expedite the transfer, which can complete within minutes. Without expedition, the process may take up to 7 days.
